

## Commonly Asked Questions

### WHAT IS CITY MUSEUM?

It is a labyrinth of tunnels, caves, forests and climbing structures created with recycled material from our city's demolished buildings. City Museum is truly unlike any museum you've seen before.

### HOW MANY PEOPLE DO YOU NEED TO BE CONSIDERED A GROUP?

A group is 15 or more people aged 3 and over, with reservations.

### WHAT ABOUT PAYMENT?

Groups must make a single payment to qualify for a group rate. Pay the day you visit for the number of people that actually attend, even if different from your reservation. We take checks (no personal checks please), cash, money orders (made out to City Museum) credit cards (Visa and MasterCard), and Purchase Orders. Purchase orders must be paid within 30 days of your visit. For booking or further information, please call 314-231-2489, ext 601.

### IS CITY MUSEUM WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBLE?

Yes. The Enchanted Caves, World Aquarium and the Bowhead Whale are wheelchair and stroller accessible. There is an elevator available for our visitors who need it. We do not rent strollers or wheelchairs.

### WHERE DO WE PARK?

After dropping off passengers at 15th St. & Lucas, buses can park in front of the meters along Delmar, free of charge. For cars and vans parking is available on our lot and 16th and Delmar. Additional parking is available across Delmar (at 15th Street). Street parking is metered, and is free on Sundays and Holidays

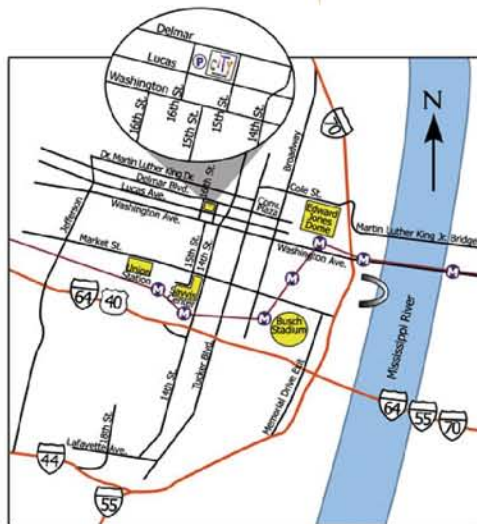

All information and rates are subject to change. To receive the Non-Profit Group Rate a tax exempt letter must be provided. No charge for adults meeting our six children to one adult ratio, with a minimum of 15 children/students paid admissions.
